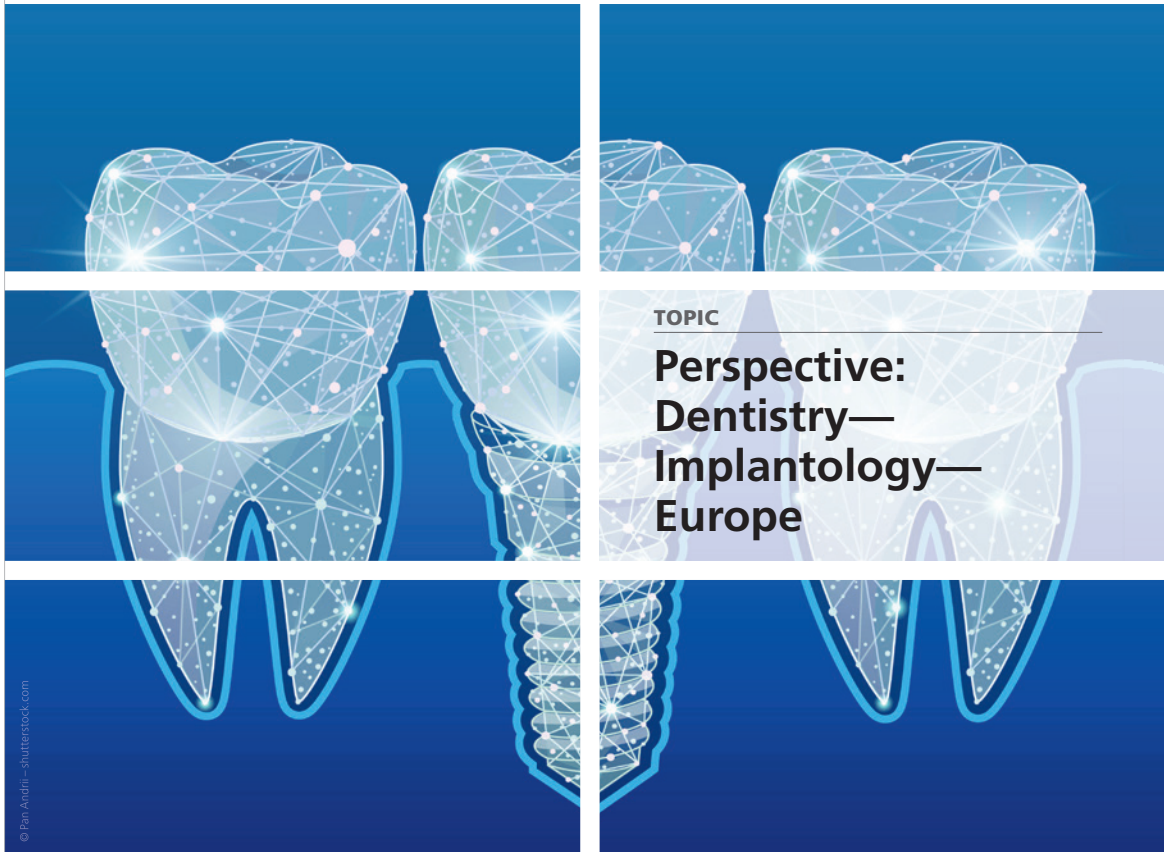

ICD rating on professional qualifications, part 2

Recognition of qualifications becomes easier across the EU

In its decision of July 2022 (C-566/20), the European Court of Justice (ECJ) once again interpreted Directive 2005/29/EC (Articles 1 and 10b). The issue was to determine, among other things, whether professional training that had not been fully completed in one Member State but had been completed in another Member State (host state) in accordance with the regulations of the host state is to be regarded as a valid professional qualification in a third Member State (Directive 2005/29/EC).

IMPROVED BONE GROWTH AND STABILIZATION OF THE IMPLANT PROSTHESIS IN THE ANTERIOR MANDIBLE

Intraoral bone regeneration within the labial portion of the anterior mandible can be unpredictable, affected by many factors including bone healing. The bone resorption phenomenon led to the implant loosening, surgical technique and patient compliance pre, peri and post operatively. This case study demonstrates the use of a novel implant design together with a structured approach (ICD) particulate allopast graft material in the anterior mandible with immediate placement and loading.

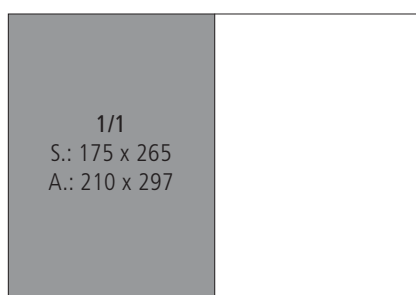

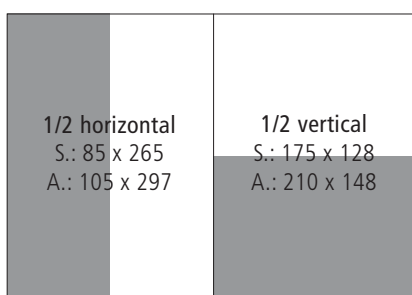

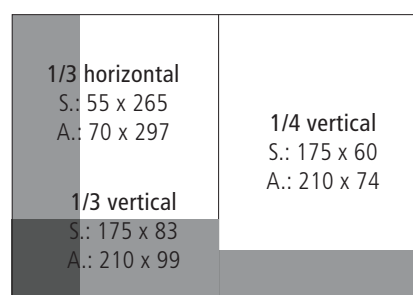
