A new simulation centre for education and training

The University of Sarajevo is setting the pace

The Faculty of Dental Medicine and the University Dental Clinic in Sarajevo have opened a new centre for education and training and are actively seeking partners for serious cooperation in the European dental education sector.

At the invitation of the University of Sarajevo and the Croatian Dental Chamber (CDC), BDIZ EDI president Christian Berger travelled to Sarajevo to tour the newly built simulation centre at the university dental clinic. The guests from Croatia and Germany were given a guided tour of the state-of-the-art simulation facility, which was built and equipped specifically for educational and training activities, by the clinic's management.

A working meeting was also held to explore the potential for future collaboration with BDIZ EDI. "The aim of this meeting is to strengthen professional and academic cooperation between the institutions, with a particular focus on joint educational activities and faculty exchanges," said Prof. Muhamed Ajanović, dean of the faculty.

Key topics on the meeting agenda included the accreditation system for professional training courses in EU countries (with a focus on Croatia and Bosnia and Herzegovina), international recognition of continuing education credits for jointly organised courses and integrating postgraduate specialist training programmes into everyday clinical practice and dental coordination.

The simulation system is designed to open new avenues for integrating standards and sharing experiences among colleagues from the region and across the EU.

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
