- · Alleviate crowding, overlapped, rotated teeth and high canines
- Correct anterior cross bites
- · Close spaces
- Treat open bites of dento-alveolar ori-
- Level the gingival zeniths
- · Treat deep bites
- Over-erupt teeth destined to be replaced with implants to increase the bone available for placement
- · Provide rounded arches, free of crowding, for future veneer prepara-

However, Six Month Smiles is not generally used to treat the following conditions:


- Correction of molar relationships and posterior bite discrepancies
- Large open bites and those of skeletal origin
- · Bilateral cross bites
- Midline discrepancies.
