Guided implant placement with CERALOG in the aesthetic zone

Dr Frank Maier/Tübingen (GER)

After extensive block augmentation in Regio 12 and 22, the insertion of two-piece CERALOG Hexalobe zirconia implants is planned. Following the removal of the osteosynthesis, a tooth-supported guide is inserted and the implant bed is prepared according to backward planning. After the implant placement, the compromised soft tissue is reinforced with a connective tissue graft. Optionally, the preoperatively fabricated individual abutments and temporary crowns will be placed.
