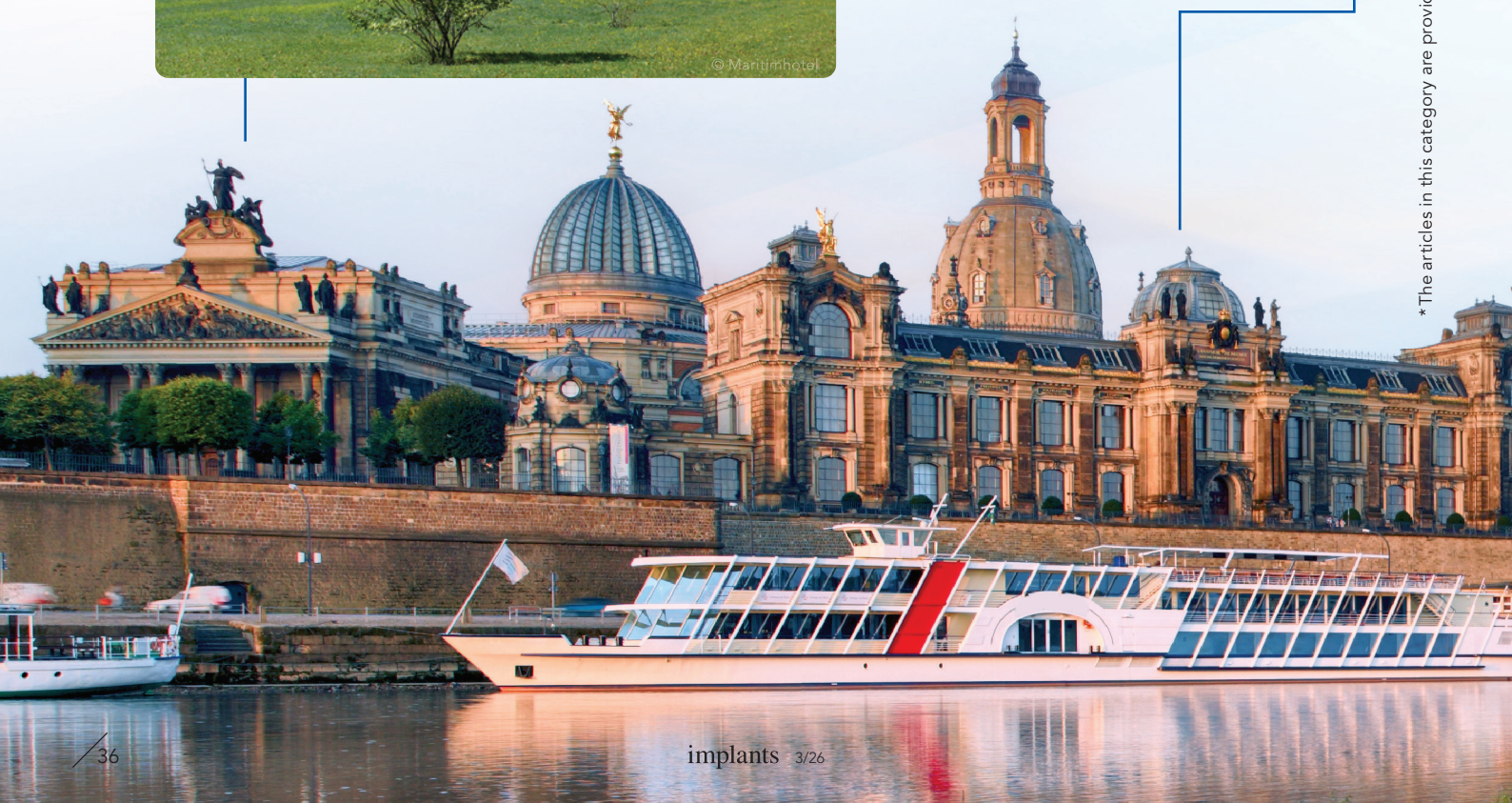
MORE THAN LECTURES AND EXPERT INSIGHTS

The programme will also offer young dentists practical guidance as they enter the field, along with valuable opportunities to connect with experienced speakers and like-minded peers.

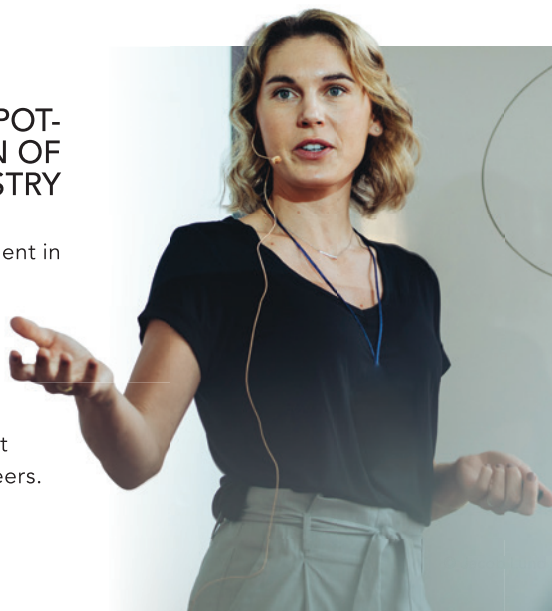


TABLE CLINICS: FOCUSED LEARNING THROUGH DIRECT EXCHANGE
